MIDDLE STREET SYNAGOGUE PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY (FEBRUARY 2026)

Middle Street Synagogue is owned by the Brighton & Hove Hebrew Congregation. Middle Street Synagogue is a private building and access is strictly controlled. Refer to the separate Access Policy (2026).

PERSONAL FILMING & PHOTOGRAPHY

Personal filming and photography is not allowed in Middle Street Synagogue unless permission is sought and granted prior to any visit taking place. Permission must be sought from the Brighton & Hove Hebrew Congregation Liaison Officer and confirmation received in writing (by email) stating the specific terms of the agreement.

If personal photography has been permitted in advance it may not be used to earn money, promote businesses, or given to photography libraries or agencies. It may not be published on social media channels unless express consent has been given.

You may take photographs of the exterior of Middle Street Synagogue from Middle Street.

USE OF DRONES

The use of drones is forbidden unless consent has been sought and acquired, and risk assessments have been arranged and agreed with the Liaison Officer. Any agreement regarding the use of drones is also contingent on the Liaison Officer receiving copies of up-to-date insurance and drone licenses.

COMMERCIAL & PROFESSIONAL FILMING & PHOTOGRAPHY

Commercial and professional filming and photography, including content captured by influencers, social media auditors, and citizen journalists, with the express purpose of earning money cannot be undertaken at Middle Street Synagogue without advance discussion and permission from the Brighton & Hove Hebrew Congregation Liaison Officer. This may entail a contract being in place which will be signed by both parties. Content which has been captured in this way without our express permission will be reported to social media companies for removal.

FUNDS RAISED

The money raised from commercial and professional filming and photography fees helps to support the ongoing conservation and restoration work at Middle Street Synagogue.
